- 2. Critically examine the relevance of Sigmund Freud, Carl Jung and Jacques Lacan to contemporary studies of psychoanalysis, sexuality and emotion in relation to literature.
- 3. Examine in depth the key contributions of Karl Marx, Fredriech Engels, Frederic James, Raymond Williams, Antonio Gramsci and Terry Eagleton to contemporary scholarship on Marxist theorizations (20 marks)
