b. The principle of legal personality was first formulated by the House of Lords in its famous decision in Salomon V. Salomon (1897) where Lord MacNaughten was emphatic that the company is at law a different person altogether from the subscribers to the memorandum.

However, in exceptional circumstances, the law ignores the separate legal personality of the company in favour of the realities behind the legal façade.
